## Kayhan President: 'True Promise' **Source of National Pride**

TEHRAN -- President Ebrahim Raisi has praised Iran's strikes last month on the Israeli-occupied territories in retaliation for the regime's earlier aggression on the Iranian diplomatic mission in Syria as a source of national pride.

Raisi made the statement in a televised interview broadcast live on Tuesday night while elaborating on the aspects of Operation True Promise, which Iran carried out in the late hours of April 13.

He said the operation should be discussed in various meetings and scientific, research, political and security circles.

"Operation True Promise is a source of national pride and is considered a turning point in consensus-building measures across the country, and everyone praised this deed."

Raisi said the Zionist regime's aggression against the Iranian Embassy in Syria bespoke the occupying entity's desperation, adding that the Islamic Republic's reprisal was a punishment for the regime as promised by Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei.

"The Zionist regime is beset by desperation and defeat. One of the manifestations of this desperation is the attack on the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Damascus; an act that contravened all international laws and regulations," he said.

"Subsequently, the Leader of the Islamic Revolution asserted that the Zionist regime would be punished and this promise was fulfilled by our combatants."

Raisi also said the operation was a clear manifestation of the rationality of the Islamic Revolution and put on display the cooperation between the military sector, diplomacy and media.

"All sectors cooperated in this operation and proved that a strong Iran can remove the shadow of war from the country and take the military option off the table," he

In a multi-pronged attack, dubbed Operation True Promise, the Iranian armed forces launched dozens of drones and missiles at the occupied territories late on April 13 in response to the regime's aggression on the Iranian diplomatic premises in the Syrian capital, Damascus, on April 1.

### Envoy Rejects Any Resistance **Axis Role in Operation**

UNITED NATIONS (Dispatches) -- Iran's permanent ambassador to the United Nations has roundly dismissed the Zionist regime's groundless accusations and provocative rhetoric against the Islamic Republic, stressing that no resistance group was involved in the country's legitimate missile and drone strikes against the occupied territories.

In two identical letters addressed to United Nations Secretary General Antonio Guterres and UN Security Council President Pedro Comissário Afonso Amir Saeid Iravani unequivocally rejected the lies and misinformation against Iran raised by the Israeli ambassador to the UN, Gilad Erdan, in a letter dated April 19, 2024.

claims, Iran has consistently upheld international law, adhered to the principles of the UN Charter, and complied with UN Security Council resolutions.

"Moreover, Iran has played an active role in promoting international peace and security through constructive participation in multiple spheres," Iravani said.

The Iranian diplomat highlighted that the Islamic Republic made it clear in the letters dated April 13 and 30, 2024 (S/2024/305-S/2024/349) that its extensive strikes in the late hours of April 13 were conducted directly and officially solely by Iran, and in response to the Israeli recurring military aggressions, particularly its at-tive." "Contrary to such unfounded tack on April 1 against the Iranian

diplomatic premises in the Syrian capital Damascus.

"Iran's action was necessary, legitimate, and fully in line with its inherent right to self-defense under the UN Charter. The action only targeted military objectives and was carried out carefully and with prior notification to prevent civilian harm," Iravani said.

"No resistance groups were involved in Iran's legitimate action and any assertions to the contrary are rejected," he added.

The envoy said Iran, in to Israel's assertions, does not have proxies in the West Asia region, and "no individual, group, or nation operates under Iran's direc-

#### **Iran: Rafah Invasion Aims to Sabotage Int'l Push to Stop War**

TEHRAN -- Iran has strongly condemned Israel's invasion of the densely-populated city of Rafah in southern Gaza despite international warnings that it would create a humanitarian ca-

Foreign Ministry spokesman Nasser Kan'ani said the move is aimed at sabotaging international efforts to stop the regime's genocidal war in Gaza.

The Iranian official made the remarks after Israeli forces seized control of the Rafah border crossing, cutting off a vital

route for humanitarian aid for

an estimated 1.5 million Pal-

estinians sheltering in the city bordering Egypt.

Kan'ani said Israel's invasion of the crossing shows the savagery of a rogue regime holding no commitment to any international norm and threatening international peace and security.

"This move by the Zionist regime has been made to render international efforts at the cessation of war and ending the genocide in Gaza futile and with the sole purpose of serving the individual and collective interests of


the Zionists," he said. Kan'ani reiterated that the key to peace and security in the re-

gion is the "immediate and unconditional" cessation of hostilities in the Gaza Strip and the occupied West Bank.

He urged all international actors to mount pressure on the Israeli regime to stop the war.

Kan'ani said the responsibility for the crimes and bloodshed in Rafah lies with the Israeli regime and its main supporter, the United States.

"Iran once again calls on the international legal institutions to investigate the crimes against humanity committed by the apartheid regime and to bring its leaders to trial."

#### FM: West **Pleaded Iran** Not to Hit Hard

TEHRAN -- Iran's foreign minister said here Wednesday the West asked the Islamic Republic to exercise restraint and lower the intensity of its retaliation before Iran's daring strikes last month on the Israeli-occupied territories in response to the regime's deadly attack on the Iranian diplomatic mission in Syria.

"Ahead of the operation, the request of the Westerners was that if you want to respond, do not hit hard and reduce the intensity of the operation," Hussein Amir-Abdollahian told reporters after a cabinet meeting.

"Ever since it was decided to conduct Operation True Promise, intensive contacts by the Westerners and the U.S.'s allies in Europe were established with Iran, and their first request was for Iran to exercise restraint and to not respond, to which we firmly stated that the response will definitely be given to the Israeli regime," he

Stressing that the Islamic Republic decided by itself as to when and how carry out the operation, Amir-Abdollahian said, "We did not allow any decisions to be made under pressure from others, but we told the Western and American side that the root cause is in the Gaza crisis that should be resolved and they should focus on that issue."

The top diplomat said Iran had issued a prior notice for the United States and the regional countries where Washington has bases about the Islamic Republic's retaliatory strikes on

"Two days before the operation, we announced to the American side and the countries where the U.S. has bases that our targets are not the neighbors or American bases but the Israeli regime," Amir-Abdollahian said.

"In the notice, we warned that if the U.S. takes action against Iran's interests, our response against the U.S. bases in the region will be immediate and decisive."

The minister said the regional countries hosting the U.S. bases were cautioned by the Islamic Republic that "our relations are based on brotherhood but if the U.S. makes the slightest
